Rates: \$30/night for up to two people. Additional people after two are \$10 per person each night: \$30/night for 1 to 2 people. \$40/night for 3 people. \$50/night for 4 people. \$60/night for 5 people.

Reservation: Please call Emily at the Wesley Forest office to check availability and to obtain the Reservation Form. Then complete the Reservation Form and email, mail, or fax it back to the Wesley Forest Office.

Deposit: Is equal to the minimum charge per night for your stay. Deposit and completed reservation form must be received in the Wesley Forest office within two weeks of the initial reservation request date.

Payment: Final payment will be due upon arrival. Cash or check only. We cannot accept credit or debit cards.

Amenities

The Minister's Cabin sleeps a total of 5 people. It may be rustic, but it has everything you need for a nice little get-away. It's a one room cabin with a small kitchenette area, bathroom, main room, and small loft. We provide some basics in the cabin, but you will need to bring some things from home to make it nice and cozy.

Kitchenette: The kitchenette offers a small mini fridge, microwave, coffeepot, hot plate, and tea kettle. We stock it with basic supplies such as some cooking utensils, a pot, a pan, coffee filters, and coffee cups. There is a small wash basin with dish soap, dish cloth, and drying towel for washing dishes.

Bathroom: Shower stall, toilet, sink, mirror – it may not be much but it sure beats an outhouse! It does have heat.

Beds: There is a bunk bed that has a full size mattress on the bottom and a twin size mattress on top. Bunk bed mattresses are spring mattresses. There are two camp mattresses located in the loft which are not spring. **Bedding is not provided. Please be sure to bring your own from home.**

Other: Small wood burning stove (we provide the wood), desk and chair, ceiling fan, electric heat wall unit in main cabin and bathroom, cleaning supplies, kitchen bar area for eating, floor and table lamps, overhead lighting, pad lock with key for you to lock the cabin if you leave.

Be sure to bring to the cabin:

Bedding and towels

Toiletries

Food that can be prepared in a microwave or on a two burner hot plate

Specific kitchen supplies you'll need for any meals you're preparing (we provide a limited number of kitchen utensils)

Flashlight

Things from home to make your stay more comfortable (books, games, etc)

Directions

The Minister's Cabin is part of Wesley Forest Camp. Please visit www.susumcamps.org for driving directions to Wesley Forest. We strongly recommend you do NOT use your GPS. After you cross over Penns Creek bridge, you will take your first right turn back the gravel lane. The Minister's Cabin is the first small cabin on your right. *There is parking in front of the cabin's chimney. Please do not park in the grass.*

Arrival and Departure Times

Arrival is available anytime after noon. We ask that all users are out of the cabin by 5pm on the day of departure.

Please be sure to communicate arrival and departure times with the Site Director prior to your visit.

Refund Policy

Deposits are refundable (minus a \$10 processing fee) when cancellations are received 30 days prior to the scheduled reservation. Cancellations received less than 30 days prior to the reservation will result in the forfeiture of the full deposit.

Damage Policy

All damages (including graffiti) will be assessed and billed to the contact at the rate of cost of repair and/or replacement.

Wesley Forest Camp and Retreat

Wesley Forest is a year round Christian camp and retreat facility. For this reason, the cabin is not available for rental June-August as this is our summer camping season. September thru May it is possible that a renting group will be using Penns Creek Lodge which is located across from the Minister's Cabin. Wesley Forest values community and respect, so please be respectful of our rental groups. When you are renting the Minister's Cabin, we welcome you to hike on the Wesley Forest trails at your own risk. Any other time of year, please be sure to confirm permission from the Site Director to hike on Wesley Forest property. Please do not fish in the dam water in front of the Minister's Cabin. Rather, we invite you to take the short walk to Penns Creek to enjoy world class trout fishing. All fishermen and women in Penns Creek must follow PA Fish and Boat Commission rules and guidelines. Absolutely no spikes may be worn in the Minister's Cabin or on the Penns Creek Lodge board walk. Please seek permission from the Site Director before fishing in the Wesley Forest catch and release lake.

Other things:

We ask that all guests leave the cabin as they found it. This includes light cleaning of the bathroom, sweeping, and gathering of all trash before departure

Smoking is not permitted inside of the Minister's Cabin and cigarette butts must be disposed of by the individual

Guests must follow all posted Wesley Forest signs

No outside fires at the Minister's Cabin

No drugs or firearms are permitted

Pets are not permitted

Hunting and trapping is not permitted on Wesley Forest property
